- 5. Pres. Irrera noted the recent 5-Star MOAA awards (slide 2): Allen Allegretto (webmaster/IT) 5-Star Harris Communications award, Allan Turner (newsletter) 5-Star Harris Communications award; SENCLAND Chapter 5-Star Level of Excellence award.
- 6. Finances: Treasurer Anna Marie Allegretto (slides 4, 5 & 6) gave an update; 2023 income way above expenses due to a large individual donation; balance at \$32,852.
- 7. Membership: Chair Al Schroetel (slides 6 thru 9) noted that gains are good, personal contact is still the best recruiting method, NRT lists are getting smaller, are sent to service directors to work with. SENCLAND recruits the most members among NC chapters.
- 8. Nominations: Committee chair Ken Klassen (slides 10 & 11) presented a slateo f nominees for the 2024 2026 service period (noting that Greg Cook is a new USN dir. Candidate, and the Barry Coyle and Mike Apicella will continue to serve as chairs of their committees (Leg. Special Events/Programs: Allan Turner (filing in for chair Irene Glaeser)(slides 13 thru 15) Noted a limit of 20 for the USCG tour at Oak Island on 20 Oct (details in newsletter); discussion on payment for guest meals; discussion on raising meal prices as Blue Water prices increase no decision for now. Ire3ne will attempt to find out what price increases BW will impose on us prior to new contract on 1/1/24. Rather than do multiple price increases to our members, we will do just one once that price can be accurately identified.
- 11. E-Mail Service: Allen Allegretto, IT Whiz, (slides 16 thru 18) discussed and recommended an "automated" e-mail/registration/notices system called "Constant Contact" that costs \$12 per month. He displayed formats, options, access, etc. He will send out a trial action and report results to the board. Lengthy discussions and explanations with Q & A. Pres. will lead the "beta tests."
